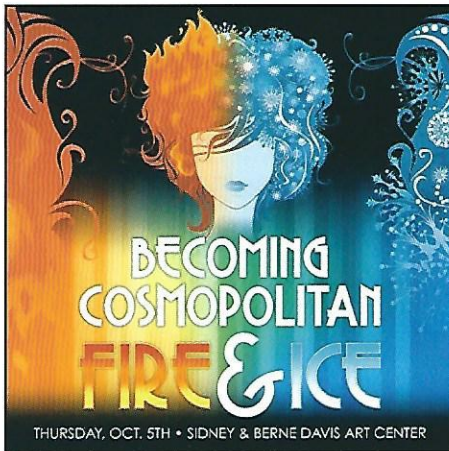


## Becoming Cosmopolitan Coming Soon to Downtown Fort Myers

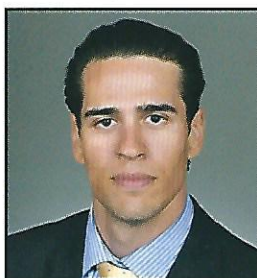

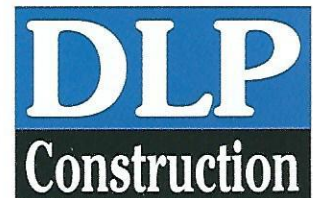
